Proceedings of Meeting held on 08.06.2017 with the Candidates

The Returning Officer, Election to the State Veterinary Council, West Bengal-2017 has conducted a meeting with the Candidates of the said election on 08.06.2017 at 4.00 p.m. The following Candidates are present in the meeting:

At first the Returning Officer explained how Ballot Papers have been randomized and how Envelopes (Form XIV) have been prepared for sending to the electors. The details process followed for preparing the envelopes are as follows:

2222 nos. of Ballot Paper Covers containing one Ballot Paper in each cover have been randomized at a time in a large carton. From the Carton one Ballot Paper Cover containing one Ballot Paper in each has been randomly picked up and inserted within Outer Cover (Form-XIV) which has been finally kept within an Envelope for sending to the elector.

Following points have also been explained -

1. Sealing of all the Ballot Boxes will be performed on 12.06.2017 at 10.30 am with locks and keys in presence of all available candidates or their representatives. There will be one or two linear holes on the top of each Ballot Box. These holes will also be sealed with paper.
2. Each day paper seal of the first Ballot Box (being used for dropping ballot papers) will be opened at 11 a.m. and resealed at 4.00 p.m. from 12.06.2017 to 19.7.2017 except Saturday, Sunday and other Govt. holidays or till the first Ballot Box is filled up.
3. When first ballot box is filled up with polled ballot papers contained in the envelope (from – XIV), it will be sealed in presence of all available candidates or their representatives, kept in safe custody for counting and next Ballot Box will be used.

4. Envelope (Form -XIV) containing declaration and envelope containing ballot paper will be dropped by one Assistant Returning Officer without verification of the contents as per stipulated schedule from 12.06.2017 to 19.7.2017 from 11 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday and other Govt. holidays.

5. Candidates /their authorized representatives may attend during sealing process of Ballot Boxes and may remain present when one elector comes to drop the envelope (Form-XIV) or postman comes to deliver such envelopes sent by the electors by post.

6. The office room where the Ballot Box is kept will remain open during receiving and dropping of Ballot Papers and candidates /their authorized representative may observe receiving and dropping of Ballot Papers as per stipulated schedule but are not allowed to enter in the receiving room.

7. Candidates will have to submit in person the authorization and revocation form for authorization and revocation of their Representatives. During submission of the Authorisation, the Authorised Representative is required to remain present with any valid ID proof.

8. Election process, system of numbering in outer envelope (Form -XIV) and declaration (Form -XI) are discussed in the meeting.

9. Only total number of Envelopes (From – XIV) containing cast Ballot Paper and declaration received from the Elector either by post or in persons and the number of undelivered envelopes containing Ballot Papers & other related papers (sent by the Returning Officer to the electors) returned from the post office will be informed every day through notice board.

Candidates present in the meeting have been satisfied with the explanations made in different issues. Finally, the meeting have been ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
