- d) Furnish copies of the State Veterinary Register to Veterinary Council of India as per provisions of section 23(4) of the Act.
- e) Renewal of registration (as per provisions of Sec.52 of the Act.)
- f) Removal of name from the Register (as per provision of section 52 & 49(1) of the Act.)
- g) Transfer of Registration to other State Veterinary Council (as per provision of section 52 of the Act.)
- h) Conduct Council election for formation of Council Board.
- i) Issuing of Provisional registration of internees after successful completion of B.V.Sc. &A.H.
- j) Council implement the standard professional conduct, etiquette and code of ethics for veterinary practitioners under provision of Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984

2) Other Activities: Besides mandatory responsibilities Council has discharges the following other activities:

- a) Organize workshops, Seminars and other technical programmes for updating the knowledge of field veterinarians as a part of continuing Veterinary Education Programme.
- b) Provide its infrastructures like auditorium, conference hall and guest house to the Dept. of A.R.D. and other organizations to perform their different technical as well as official programmes.
- c) Council has maintained a good library with recent edition of Standard Volumes of books on clinical and non-clinical subjects.
- d) Council has its own website www.wbvc.in in which records of registration, renewal, address change, qualification and other related matter are regularly updated for providing necessary information to the veterinarians.

Council Library



To ensure ready availability of authentic latest information for the intending veterinarians the Council has built up a modest collection of 324 books on different subjects of veterinary medicine, veterinary surgery, gynaecology & obstetrics, animal genetics, poultry science and a good number of latest books on microbiology. Special volumes on canine and feline medicines will be of immense value to the veterinary practitioners. Important books on wildlife management, health care and treatment are available in the library. The small library and reprographic section are functioning fairly well. Members of the council, research scholars and veterinary practitioners are evincing interest in the library.

The Council proposes to establish a modern information centre along with this library. Veterinarians registered with the council will be provided with technical and academic information of professional interest as and when required. The council has ambitious programme of expanding on line dissemination of special features of professional expertise.

The Council will pull up all possible resources to develop this special professional library in the interest of the veterinarians. Efforts are being made to subscribe more technical personals.
